MESSAGE FROM THE ASSISTANT RABBAN



Greetings Nobles,

I realize that everyone is having a some "cabin fever" now, we all miss meeting with our fellow Nobles and Ladies. Hang in there, things will certainly get better. How can I be so sure? Because mankind has fought diseases like these before.

The bubonic plague of the medieval era took a huge toll in human life, about one-third of the population of Europe. In some places, entire towns and villages disappeared. The plague would reappear at intervals and still crops up occasionally in the present day. It was finally contained by controlling the rat infestations in cities and keeping plague-carrying ships from docking. In fact, this is where the word quarantine comes from. Ships would have to wait for

40 days to prove that there were no plague carriers onboard. In Medieval Latin, the word quarentena means 40.

For many years smallpox claimed up to 30% of those infected and most of the survivors were left scarred for life. When a vaccine was first developed, many people didn't trust it and actually opposed it with editorials and satirical cartoons. However the vaccine worked spectacularly and the last case of smallpox was diagnosed in 1977.

I can remember when there was great concern about polio and seeing pictures of wards full of polio patients in iron lungs. This fearful disease was almost completely eradicated by the Salk Vaccine and other means. How many of us were given the pink sugar cube? I was.

Typhoid fever is caused by a type of salmonella and was spread through food and water. The most famous case was "Typhoid Mary" who didn't suffer any symptoms herself, but spread the disease while working in restaurants. Proper sanitation and safe food handling practices have controlled typhoid. Now you know why there's "employees must wash hands" signs in restaurant bathrooms.

For anyone who likes to think about odd coincidences, the decades numbered 20 seem to have an unusual amount of disasters. In the 1720s there was a small outbreak of bubonic plague in Europe. In the 1820s it was cholera. And there's been a lot of comparison between the 1918 Spanish Flu outbreak that lasted till 1920 and the current situation.

So let's "keep calm and carry on" and we can get through these rough times together.

I hope to be able to meet with everyone soon.

When I was raised a Master Mason in 1984 my Dad presented me with my Maternal Grandfather's Masonic ring. As far as I can trace, I believe that my Grandfather joined the Masonic lodge in the 1930's and I have no idea when he got his ring.

It wasn't until recently that my Dad shared a story about my Grandfather's ring that I had never heard before. My parents were born and raised in Texas and went to school together. When my Dad graduated from high school he moved to Napa, California to live with his brother and work in the ship yard. After working in the ship yard long enough to afford a train ticket, he sent my mom the money and asked her to buy a train ticket and come to California where they would be

My mom had been waiting for this time to come and was very excited about coming to California to marry the love of her life. As she went to board the train and leave Texas for California, her Dad gave her his Masonic ring and told her to wear it on a chain around her neck and when people saw the ring, they would take care of her if she ever needed help. Indeed, while she was on the train there was a lady who saw the ring and offered help. The lady bought my mom food and made sure that my mom made it safely to California and into the arms of my Dad.

As the father of two daughters, I can't imagine sending one of my daughters on a train to be married and I don't know if I would have ever thought to send my daughter with my masonic ring to ensure that she would be well taken care of.

This story made me really stop and think. What great faith in Masonry my Grandfather had, that he knew his ring would provide her safety and security in the hands of men who were complete strangers to her. I hope that we all have this much faith in our brotherhood and that we as Masons would treat each other and each other's families with the same respect. Whenever I see other Masons in public, I always make a point to greet them. I enjoy the connection that we share in this great fraternity. I encourage you to spread Masonry throughout our community in whatever ways you are able to. Prior to hearing this story I don't know if I would have looked at a girl wearing a masonic ring around her neck and figured that her Dad had given her that ring as a sign for all of us Masons to watch out and protect her. We live in times when we all could use someone to watch out for us and as Masons we need to ensure that we are doing everything to watch out for others. I share this story about my mom to give everyone a chance to stop and think of that young girl traveling with the protection of her Dad's masonic ring. The next time you put on your masonic ring I hope that you will consider the great power that the square and compass has to provide identification and protection.


Christmas in July

Anniversary of the Editorial Without Words

Tuesday, May 26, 2020

The photo known as the "Editorial Without Words" is one of the Shriners fraternity's most recognizable images. It was taken almost by accident, 50 years ago, on June 11, 1970, in Evansville, Indiana. This special moment, captured for all time, eloquently illustrates the relationship between the Shriners fraternity and Shriners Hospitals for Children.

Hadi Shriners in Evansville was holding its annual summer picnic. Patients were invited, and everyone enjoyed a day of food, fun and carnival rides. Toward the end of the day, Shriner Al Hortman, who became a Shriner after his daughter, Laura, was treated at Shriners Hospitals for Children, noticed a young girl who needed help. On this day, Noble Hortman lifted Bobbi Jo Wright and her crutches and carried her from ride to ride. A local newspaper photographer, Randy Dieter, captured the photo with a long lens as the two walked past him. Dieter wouldn't realize until much later how much impact that single image would have. Neither would the Shriners, or Bobbi Jo herself.

Today, Bobbi Jo lives independently and is active in her church. She spends much time and energy traveling and speaking on behalf of Shriners Hospitals for Children, and meeting and encouraging other patients and families.

The famous photo has been reproduced on stained-glass windows, mosaics, tie tacks, pins and more. A larger-than-life replica of the "Editorial Without Words" stands outside the Shriners International Headquarters building in Tampa, Florida, and statues mark many temples and Shriners Hospitals locations. A version of the image is used as the Shriners Hospitals for Children logo.




