

## **Shriners Medical Center for Children**

Fezzy's Flutters Or Joe's Jabbers

So what is going on at the Shrine Center in Pasadena? Even amidst the Covid epidemic we are making progress in our services to our young patients. You may have noticed the outreach we make with TV ads. Alex does a great job sharing our goals and efforts and encouraging public support.

The facility is referred to as an ASC or Ambulatory Surgical Center. Patients walk in for procedures and leave the same day. This has drastically reduced costs. Should someone need overnight care, we pass them up the street to Huntington Hospital or over to Children's Hospital in Los Angeles. Our partnership with CHLA is growing and it allows our teams to do procedures at their facility which is much larger, and Doctors from CHLA can do procedures at our facility meeting needs such as urology and neurology which is outside of our usual skin and bone work. Many patients from CHLA also bring insurance dollars into the program, a real benefit.

You may have heard that we have a satellite facility in Tijuana. This is another money saver as it treats patients without lengthy travel, border and language challenges. I will share more on this after we have our visit there.

Dr Cho always expresses his appreciation of the extra involvement which the medical staff has in publishing and providing training and workshops in such areas as genomics, research and non-opoid pain management. We seem to have a happy and friendly staff that is continuously sampling and improving how well they are meeting the needs of our patients.

As we rise out of our pandemic winter, we hope to soon have an open house at the facility.

And one last thought, if you ever wondered why we have clowns in the Shrine.... I mean the ones who actually dress up for the part, we have been trying to educate the staff which had no clue as to the valuable role they can play in cheering up our kids.

#### **CUSTOMIZED TREATMENTS**

Scoliosis is a disorder that results in a curved spine. The condition causes the spine to take on a curved appearance, sometimes similar to an "S" or "C" shape. No two cases are alike. Some children develop the condition during infancy, while others don't exhibit symptoms until they're approaching adolescence. Every patient is unique, and Shriners Hospitals for Children's medical teams create custom treatment plans for each child based on the severity of their condition.

Casting and bracing: Serial casting is often an effective option to slow progression of a spinal curve. A plaster cast gently and precisely helps straighten the spine. Children typically wear a cast for two to three months, then transition to a new one. Bracing is one of the least invasive treatment options for scoliosis. At Shriners Hospitals for Children, every scoliosis brace is customized to the individual patient to best address the severity and location of their spinal curve.

Spinal fusion: Not every child will need surgical intervention. When surgery is the best option, our renowned orthopedic specialists have a wealth of experience. In fusion surgery, screws and rods are used to correct the curve, then bone grafts fuse the spine to hold the correction in place.

Vertebral body tethering (VBT): This treatment is an alternative to fusion surgery for certain patients. It was developed by our medical team at the Shriners Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. This technology helps correct the scoliosis while allowing a more natural motion, unlike fusion surgeries.


