



"The Tie That Binds"

You were once asked: What makes you a Mason? Your answer: My obligation.

In our rituals we have our obligations which are given at installations and initiations.

Masons have three sets of these, one for each degree. And before they may move up to the next degree they must present their obligation from memory in Lodge.

The obligations are a strong tie which unites brothers with a common experience and commits them to follow its dictates, having sworn to do so on the holy writings of their faith.

The first obligation is to maintain, in secrecy, the modes of recognition and communication of ritual. In the next degree we promise support and care, fair dealing and honesty. And the list of commitment is longest for the third degree. We will come when called, asssist when needed, promise confidentiality and soft personal counsel, conform to our principles and guidelines, admit only properly qualified persons, protect and respect the women of a brother's family, recognize a brother in distress and give him and his dependents aid.

By making the effort to memorize the obligations, the commitment is strengthened and reinforced. This provides familiar and appropriate reminders when occasions call for their application.

With these sworn commitments we can feel confidence in the integrity of a brother.

Only recently I was asked what one should say at a celebration of life if called upon to speak. My response was simple. Even if I had not personally met this brother, *I knew him*. It is the obligations that cements us into one common body of Masons.









A message from Chuck Wilson

OLD REDDY

Shriners love parades. And parade spectators love the shriners! Whether its a regimental marching unit, crazy cars, motorcycles, floats or clowns, people appreciate, enjoy and look forward watching the shriners "strut their stuff". It's a long tradition. Southern California temples have plenty of opportunity to join in the fun. El Bekal participates in at least six or seven parades each year. But this story is not about parades. This is about our oldest, biggest and historical parade participant: El Bekal's venerated and beloved fire engine—"Old Reddy".

A history lesson: The El Bekal Clowns purchased the truck in 1998. It became a parade favorite immediately. What could be more absurd and hilarious than a bunch of clowns acting up on a fire engine of all things! But the fire engine had a history before the clowns took possession. The cab and chassis came off the Ford assembly plant in August, 1964. Apache Fire Truck Company in El Monte was charged to fabricate the body and all the related systems. It was designated as a 1965 Ford F-600 (medium duty). It entered service with the Santa Margarita Fire Department in San Luis Obispo County October, 1964. utilized by that department until 1997. 1998 it was declared surplus status and sold to the clowns. Clowns drove it to its new home in Anaheim. Mechanically, a165 hp V8 engine powers the truck. Has a 5-speed manual transmission. Creature comforts? Forget it. This isn't exactly user friendly: No air conditioning, no power steering or anything. The brakes work!—maybe too good. Anything more than the slightest braking and the thing screeches to a halt. Guess the proper attitude should be, "I don't care if runs, as long as it can stop". The fire engine resides in the bull pen out in El Bekal's back-forty portion of the parking lot. Former clown/fire truck driver, Chuck Wilson expressed it best: "There are those of us who have developed a strong attachment to the

rig over the years and do the best we can to keep it good running order." Little known fact: Orginally the truck was white. Clowns changed that to the familiar red and was repainted in 2012.

Conditions change over time and the clown unit faced membership challenges. Fewer were able to take on the responsibility of care, maintenance or operation the vehicle. With Covid pandemic the club suffered further. It was decided to release ownership and turn title over to our temple. Presently there are 4 qualified to operate (including mechanics) but only one of those is the regular duty driver. Age continues to creep up and he now nears 74. Our temple could use other nobles to increase the driver roster and share in the task. So here comes the pitch:






