2020 EL BEKAL CRUISE

Final details for the 2020 El Bekal Cruise are not available yet. But the cruise itself has been finalized. The Enchanted Princess, which makes it's maiden voyage in June 2020, will sail from Barcelona, Spain on Saturday, September 5, 2020. The fantastic ports-of-call are **Gibraltar, Marseille, France, Genoa, Italy and Florence/Pisa, Italy**. The ship will arrive in **Civitavecchia, Italy** for our trip to Rome on Saturday, September 12. We have reserved 12 Balcony and 12 Interior Cabins, in addition to the Owner's Suite which Kim and I have reserved. We already have several couples signed up for the cruise at this early date. We are going through Cruise Holidays of Upland. Our contact is Bonnie and her phone number is 909-946-6033. Refundable reservations can be made at this time through Bonnie. They are refundable until May 28, 2020. A small number of mini-suites are available at this time, but they may not last. MESSAGE FROM THE HP&P



Greetings Nobles!

Some of you may have noticed that I wasn't around for a couple weeks of last month. It's because I was representing El Bekal Temple at the 103rd Supreme Session of Daughters of the Nile in Reno, Nevada where our Imperial Potentate was honored with a presentation of checks for the Shriner's Hospitals for Children. Daughters of the Nile happens to be the second largest donor organization to the Hospitals right after our Shrine itself. The immense enthusiasm for our Hospitals and the energy of these Ladies was amazing as the Queen of each Temple marched in with her Temple Banner to the accompaniment of a drum line and cheering from the crowd. The energy in the room increased as they greeted the Imperial Potentate Jim Cain and his Lady. The drum line even offered a fanfare for him. The

Imperial Potentate spoke at length about the new changes to our Hospitals and the relationship between our organizations and the dedication to this important cause. He showed a video of a recent Imperial visit to one of the Medical Centers and received official greetings from the Supreme Queen. During his speech, he remarked on the number of Shriners in the room from many Temples across the US and Canada, all of us wearing our Fezzes.

There is a close and lasting connection between our Shrine organization and the Daughters of the Nile organization that cannot be ignored. Remember that our Ladies are a resource that should not be underestimated. The energy, enthusiasm, and ingenuity of the women is boundless and can easily accomplish near impossible tasks. Don't forget that the Ladies are not constrained by Masonic rules and can approach a potential candidate. Any Ladies reading this, if you want to know more about the Daughters of the Nile, just contact my Lady Rhea, who is a Past Queen of Merret Temple in Anaheim. The Daughters of the Nile has over 25,000 members in 137 Temples in the US and Canada, and there will be one opening in Sao Paulo, Brazil in August. Nile clubs are forming in Germany, Puerto Rico, Mexico City, and the Philippines.

It might seem like I'm leaving out the Ladies Oriental Shrine of North America. I don't mean to be excluding anyone, it's just that I didn't get a chance to attend their annual convention in May of this year. El Tanya Court in Long Beach, El Riva Court in Riverside and Ra-Ma Court in Anaheim are all splendid partners of our Shrine and in our devotion to the Hospitals.

Just so you know, those checks that the Imperial Potentate received were made out in impressive amounts. The Daughters of the Nile Temples in the U.S. presented a check for over \$1,765,000. The Canadian Daughters of the Nile Temples presented another check for close to \$250,000. The Supreme Queen mentioned that close to \$900,000 was provided to the Hospitals in the form of equipment, blankets, clothes and toys for the patients, with various supplies and services from the Ladies. To date, the Daughters of the Nile have given over \$65 million to the Shrine Hospitals in under 100 years.

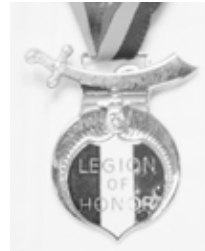

Shriners for Children Medical Center, Pasadena Happenings for May 219

Each year Shriners Hospitals Head office in Tampa Florida, assigns to each hospital in our system, a financial fund raising goal. This year, 2019, Shriners for Children Medical Center was given a goal of \$5,300,000.00, the largest amount of the twenty two (22) hospitals, although we are one of the smallest facilities. This is a great challenge. At the end of April 2019 our relatively small fund raising department has raised \$1,193,033.000, the fourth largest amount in the system. We have a long way to go, but a great start.

A few words of wisdom passed on by Dr. Robert Cho, Chief of Staff.

“A good Physician needs three abilities;
Availability
Ability
Affability”

The Medical Center Dashboard (scoreboard) for Patient Safety and Quality lists twenty (20) items that include targets for accomplishment. Two (2) examples;

1. Wrong site, wrong procedure, wrong patient.
2. Surgical site infection.

Each of these twenty two (22) items have a target of zero (0) episodes, or a target of 100% accomplishment. During the month of April, each of these twenty two (22) targets, of quality or accomplishment, were met. Every patient, every Noble and the public can be confident of the high quality of Medical Service provided by Shriners for Children Medical Center.

NEWS FLASH

The Medical Center Administration along with the Executive Board has completed a joint use agreement with CHLA (Children’s Hospital Los Angeles) that provides for Shrine Surgeons to use CHLA Surgical Facilities and Post Operative Care, for those patients that cannot be treated at the Medical Center. Ongoing discussion with CHLA should result in joint use of additional services in the CHLA system. The CHLA agreement, combined with our existing agreement with Huntington Hospital, greatly expands our service to patients and their families.

We are now in our second full year at the Medical Center, and can now compare “year to year” changes. One of these important changes is “New patient intake growth”.

From March 2018 to March 2019, new patient intake increased 7%

From April 2018 to April 2019, new patient intake increased 22%

Great work on the part of the Committee for Business Development and Community Relations.

The Temple Communications Committee has expanded.

So, stop by for a visit. No reservation required, the first lunch is on the Club and we just love company, especially Nobles.



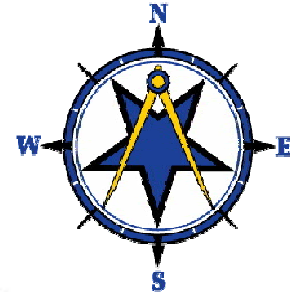

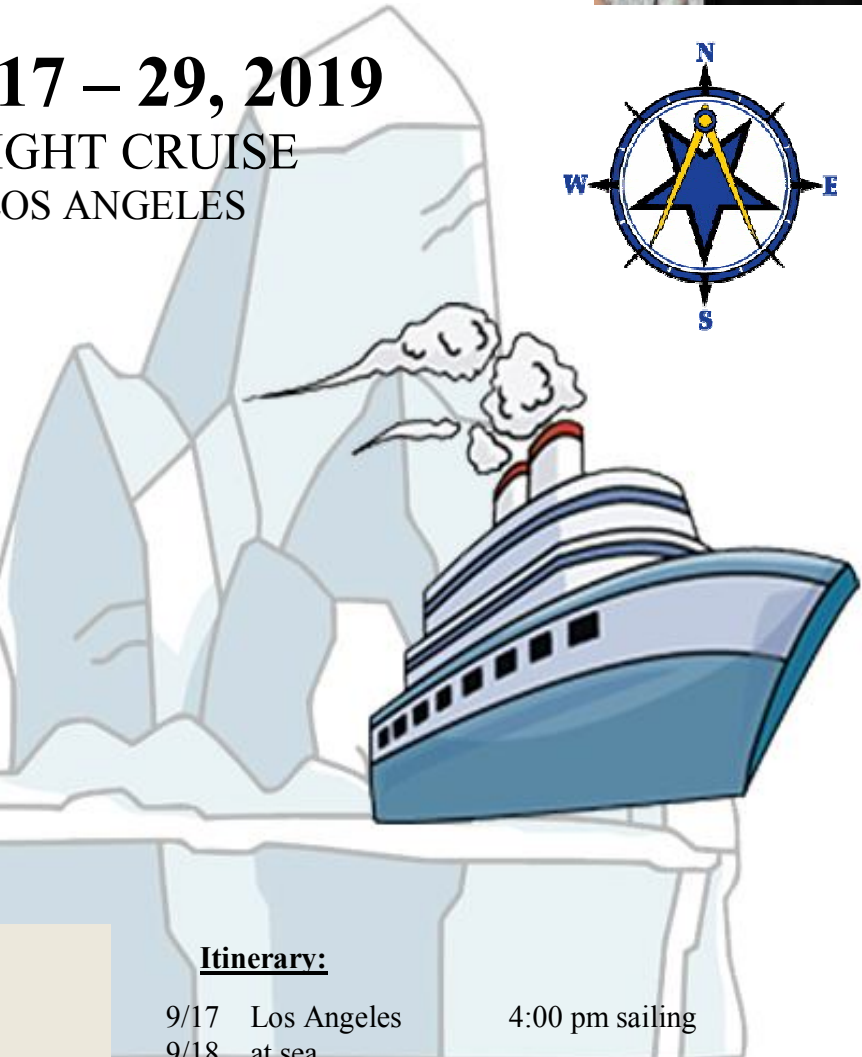

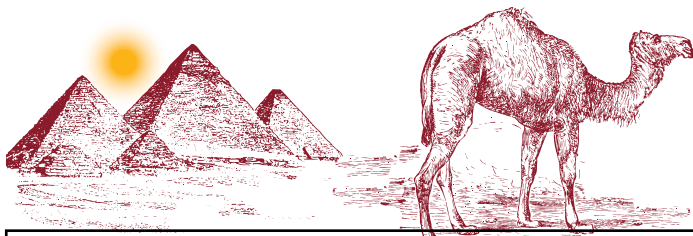
