

Hope all is well for you and your families, about a month ago Illustrious Merritt Read appointed me as Chairman of the bylaws committee with that, we put on the committee Ill Sir Roger Ross ESQ, Ill Sir Don Leger and Ill Sir John Rider to look at our bylaws. The bylaws were retyped and we added two provisions they were:

Under: §4.3 Election and Appointment.

(c) For the office of Recorder or Treasurer. The noble must be a member of El Bekal Shrine for no less than 3 years;

(d) For the Divan. A noble must be a member of Shriners International for no less than 3 years;



So, stop by for a visit. No reservation required, the first lunch is on the Club and we just love company, especially Nobles.


