Greetings Nobles,

El Bekal is in the process to reopening the Shrine center with the new Grand Lodge's rules.

We are all on pins and needles about what is going on with Covid 19 all around us right now.

The State, County, City, and Grand Lodge has a set of guide lines that we are adhering to to keep our Nobles and guest safe.

We all have to follow these guide lines.

At a high level, the applicable limitations are:

- 1. Indoor private events and meetings are not permitted in counties assigned to the purple tier. We are in tier 3 Orange.
- 2. There must be a guest list and a seating chart for any meeting or event.
- 3. Attendees must show proof of full COVID-19 vaccination or proof of a negative COVID-19 test within the last 72 hours.
- 4. The facility must create and implement a COVID-19 site prevention plan.
- 5. Under the California mask mandate, attendees must wear a face mask unless they are specifically exempted under the mandate.

- 7. Attendees self-screen for symptoms at home following CDC guidelines. Attendees with symptoms do not attend the meeting.

Greetings Nobles!

El Bekal Shrine has started holding in-person events again! Under the safety guidelines established by Grand Master Weiss, the state of California, county of Orange and the city of Anaheim, we held a successful Mother's Day Brunch with over 50 people in attendance. I know that sounds like a lot of rules to follow, but much of them are simple common sense precautions that are easy to do. Soon there's going to be more events and, God willing, things will open up even more. The biggest question is "will things ever be back to normal?" Well that all

depends on what just what normal is. Major events always cause great changes and this pandemic is not an exception. Looking back at history,

we can see that many of these changes were for the better and even those that weren't better were eventually accepted and became part of everyday life.

Going way back, the huge Bubonic Plagues of the Middle Ages gave rise to the beginnings of the middle class as the general population decreased. Those with valuable skills found ways to better exert their rights, leveraging their talents against the demands of the landed gentry and royalty. This gave rise to chartered guilds of workers, essentially the early form of trade unions, and allowed for greater ease of traveling to find work instead of being tied to the land. This was probably when the guilds of stone masons gained greater prominence and prestige and became the Freemasons.

The typhoid and cholera epidemics of the previous two centuries impacted the way food and water were handled. Food safety laws were enacted, the federal Food & Drug Administration (FDA) was set up, water purification plants were built, sanitation was taken seriously and (sorry to mention some icky stuff) human waste was no longer used as fertilizer. Those "Employees Must Wash Hands" signs in every restaurant restroom are a result of these changes and hand washing really does make a difference.

It's not just epidemics and pandemics that cause changes. Inventions, developments in transportation, shifting population and even wars can alter the way things are done. I don't think I need to mention the great changes brought about by World War II. Many of us can remember the change over from propeller aircraft to jetliners that resulted in the Jet Set culture of the 1960s and 1970s. Our grandparents and great-grandparents saw the landscape itself being altered by widespread acceptance of the automobile. Implementation of the Internet is still causing changes with no discernible end in sight.

While we can use history as a rough guide to what might happen next, there's no reliable crystal ball that will predict the future accurately. So any guesses about what happens next are just that, guesses. My humble opinion is that, even with effective vaccines available, face masks and social distancing are going to be with us for quite a while. Handshakes and casual hugs might be lose favor to fist bumps and Vulcan salutes from Star Trek. Who knows what other changes might happen in the years to come? Only time will tell.
