CHIEF RABBAN



Greetings Nobles,

We've just returned from Shriners International Imperial Sessions in Houston Texas and what a blast it was! I'm still a bit jet lagged and getting used to California weather again. It was so humid and rainy in Houston that the airport shut down right after our arrival, making us wait an extra hour for our wet luggage. It rained on and off the entire week, but abated during the Shriners block party and the Shriners Parade. It looks like The Great Architect appreciates what we Shriners do.

Besides all the events, sessions and vendors booths, several of us managed to find time for a trip to the Johnson Space Center to see the grounds, the Mission Mock-up Building and the Rocket Display Park where, among other rockets, the mighty Saturn V rocket is on display in a climate controlled building. It

had been on display outside, but the Texas weather was causing some damage by corrosion and sun bleaching. Now it's been restored to as close to original condition as possible, and is only one of three complete Saturn V rockets on public display.

I found out that there's a significant Masonic connection to the Space Program, beyond Noble John Glenn and Noble Buzz Aldrin (who claimed the moon as territory of the Grand Lodge of Texas.) Johnson Space Center is named for President Lyndon Johnson who took the Entered Apprentice Degree, but didn't continue his journey in Masonry. Some of the Shriner Astronauts were Gordon Cooper, Gus Grissom, Walter Schirra and Tom Stafford. Several other Astronauts are or were Masons, but their Shrine membership is unconfirmed. Contrary to popular belief, Astronaut Neil Armstrong was not a Mason, but his father was an active member of an Ohio Lodge.

Report on the Medical Centers (Colorado Corporation)

The Hospital/Medical Centers are doing well despite dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic over the past year and a half. The staff were very diligent about patient and their own safety and there were no outbreaks of COVID at any Shriners facility. Plans are still moving forward for greater use of Telemedicine and more small clinics and Centers of Excellence instead of a few large hospitals as part of the Vision 2035 program. New technology and medical research is bringing new hope to more patients while involving less pain and shorter recovery time. Over 64,000 telemedicine visits were conducted by Shriners Hospital staff last year, compared with only a few hundred in previous years. Partnership is continuing with the Georgia Institute of Technology Biomedical Engineering Department and Medical Research Center.

Financially, the year 2020 was better than the past few years. The funding shortfall for 2020 was around \$7,389,000. Compare to the shortfall in 2019 which was slightly under \$70 million. The Board of Directors and Trustees have pledged to continue with financially sound policies for the Hospitals and Medical Centers.

All seven items of legislation for the Colorado Corporation were passed, changing some outdated language in the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. These changes will allow expanded services in cases of severe injuries and declared disasters, as well as continuing an Oversight Committee to report on activities of the Hospitals. Our Pasadena Medical Center, soon to become the Southern California Medical Center, is allowed to continue treating sports injuries under these changes.

The newly elected Trustees are Ricky Arrocha of Abou Saad Shriners in Panama City, Panama; and Paul F. Poulin M.D. of Kora Shriners in Lewiston, Maine. Continuing as the Chairman is Imperial Sir Jerry Gantt. The new member of the Board of Directors is Tim Forbis of Korein Shriners in Rawlins, Wyoming.

Brothers-

I have seen the following post shared many times on social media recently, most recently by a Past Master of my Lodge, and felt that it rings so true as we return to our pre-pandemic routines and try to rebuild what may have been lost in our Masonic groups. I hope that you will enjoy the read and that it will have the same impact on you as it has had on me.

A man walks down the street of his hometown and sees the old Masonic lodge closed and falling apart. He had left for the service and said when he returned home he wanted to join the lodge because as a child he was so impressed by the quality of men he met there. He recalled the fish fry's and barbecues he attended there, the Christmas parties and other events.

He saw an old lady walking down the street and asked her what happened? He recalled how he would see the members gather for meetings, holding events for the community and marching in the parade. Such great men, beacons of the town, men of influence but more importantly, just great men.

The old woman stated, " My husband used to attend lodge there. For decades he would spend countless hours working to prepare for events and meetings, oh how he loved being around his Brothers. He loved being a Freemason and so looked forward to the fellowship, he loved being surrounded by good men, like minded men who knew they were something bigger than themselves."

"But what happened? ", asked the man, "Where'd they all go?"

"Well son", said the old lady, "They died or moved away but it started down this path long before that. The Brothers stopped coming, they stopped working on the lodge, they stopped holding events. When the Brothers stopped attending, the events stopped, the people stopped coming, when the people stopped coming, the fundraisers stopped, when the fundraisers stopped, the Brothers were asked to pitch in to keep their lodge alive. Unfortunately, the Brothers had more important things to do. They would have all kinds of reasons why they couldn't come give a few hours of their time.

There used to be dozens but eventually there were just a few, my husband called them 'The faithful few'. Sometimes they barely had enough to hold meetings, they couldn't do Degree work because they didn't have enough members present, they couldn't grow because they couldn't bring in new men. Sadly as those faithful few aged, they just couldn't do it all anymore. They tried but after the events stopped, so did their relations with the town folk. The people who had enjoyed the events over the years lost interest in helping out. They drained what little money they had left to try and keep it open but it all dried up. After they closed, my husband was miserable, it was the one thing he looked forward to each month and now it is gone."

The man looked on with tears in his eyes, such a great institution that did so much for its community was gone.

Our Lodges are not just buildings of brick and mortar, they are buildings of Brotherly Love. Love held between Brothers of the order and shown to our communities but they can't survive on love alone. Like any great organization, it is the members who keep it going. Much like the crops of the field will die off without the rains, our Lodges will die off without its members. We all have other things that go on, that is life, but we must make every effort to set aside the time, as little as four hours a month, to attend meetings, do the work and maintain our temple.

Truly, Brethren, "Our Lodges are not just buildings of brick and mortar, they are buildings of Brotherly Love." As we return from vacations, fears/concerns, and whatever has been keeping us from attending, let's remember that our Lodges and Temples need us and our Brothers need us. I am looking forward to the end of summer when we are home from all of our vacations and my family and I can join you all at some Shrine events!

CUSTOMIZED TREATMENTS

Scoliosis is a disorder that results in a curved spine. The condition causes the spine to take on a curved appearance, sometimes similar to an "S" or "C" shape. No two cases are alike. Some children develop the condition during infancy, while others don't exhibit symptoms until they're approaching adolescence. Every patient is unique, and Shriners Hospitals for Children's medical teams create custom treatment plans for each child based on the severity of their condition.

Casting and bracing: Serial casting is often an effective option to slow progression of a spinal curve. A plaster cast gently and precisely helps straighten the spine. Children typically wear a cast for two to three months, then transition to a new one. Bracing is one of the least invasive treatment options for scoliosis. At Shriners Hospitals for Children, every scoliosis brace is customized to the individual patient to best address the severity and location of their spinal curve.

Spinal fusion: Not every child will need surgical intervention. When surgery is the best option, our renowned orthopedic specialists have a wealth of experience. In fusion surgery, screws and rods are used to correct the curve, then bone grafts fuse the spine to hold the correction in place.

Vertebral body tethering (VBT): This treatment is an alternative to fusion surgery for certain patients. It was developed by our medical team at the Shriners Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. This technology helps correct the scoliosis while allowing a more natural motion, unlike fusion surgeries.
