# **1st CEREMONIAL MASTER**

Hopefully everyone has been having a good year....or at least have developed a good sense of humor given the Covid-19 Pandemic.

This article is my official notice to the Nobility of my intent to run for the office of Oriental Guide for the 2022 year.

For those who do not know who I am, my name is James Segerstrom. Although I am only 32 years of age, my Masonic Life has been a fascinating journey, both for myself and my family's Masonic History. I am either a 4th or 5th generation Mason (there is a photo of my Great-Great Grandpa wearing a Shriners Fez, but nothing is confirmed).

Here is a little bit of that personal Masonic Journey as of the writing of this notice... I decided to petition for the degrees of Masonry at Orange Grove Lodge No. 293 F. & A.M. back in 2007, when I turned 18. To my surprise, my Dad, Ted Segerstrom, asked me to hold off

for a month or two, because he decided that he wanted to join with me. He and I received our 1st Degree the same night as each other in 2008. I went first, as I love to remind my Dad. It can be argued that Masonry skipped a generation in the family for 20 minutes.

Eventually, I received my 3rd Degree on November 10, 2009, and 2 months later, delivered the charge for my Dad when he got his 3rd Degree

I was asked to become the Junior Steward for my Lodge for the 2011 year, and worked my way up the line through 2018, when the Lodge elected me to serve as Worshipful Master for the 2019 year. It was one of the greatest honors I could have done, to serve the Brothers of the Lodge to the best of my ability.
