
Greetings Nobles,

FUN & FELLOWSHIP COMPETITION WINNERS SHOW HOW IT'S DONE

It's all about engagement.

Entrants of the second annual Fun & Fellowship Competition had diverse ideas, but all shared a common thread: They've found that the most successful events find ways to engage nobles, families, friends and the community.

Winners of the competition were announced in July in Minneapolis, Minnesota, at Imperial Session. First place was captured by **Ainad Shriners** of Southern Illinois with their Puttin' Around Ainad event, which brought Shriners and community residents together for a memorable day of fun and fellowship.

This mini-golf tournament inside the temple featured holes designed and built by the clubs and units of Ainad. Four-person teams played scramble-style, and a chip shot 50/50 competition offered extra chances to chip balls across the auditorium into a target for 50/50 tickets.

What made the event a success? For one thing, the temple had a 100% participation rate with the clubs and units that typically meet inside the temple. Also, clubs and units that do not normally have rooms in the building came in for the day, bringing all the clubs and units together.

Taking second place was **Abou Ben Adhem Shriners** of Spring-field, Missouri, with their East-West Shrine Bowl™ Tailgate Party. Clubs and units competed in food, decorations and atmosphere categories, with new nobles from the previous year and their ladies acting as judges. New nobles also received passes to bring a guest for free to introduce them to Shriner activities.

The party created many opportunities for Shriners to bond. New nobles were introduced to many clubs and units, and the competitions sparked friendly rivalries among clubs and units. The tailgate was also a way to demonstrate for prospective members the fun and fellowship that Shriners share. The temple estimates that turnout for the event included more than 450 people.

El Zagal Shriners of Fargo, North Dakota, snared third place in the competition. The temple's Bismarck/Mandan Shrine club hosted an indoor car show, the first in Bismarck, North Dakota, since the 1980s. It was a two-day show with space for 100 cars and many vendors. Many of the units in Bismarck and Mandan combined to pull the event together. The exciting car show gave other nobles a great excuse to visit from the rest of El Zagal's jurisdiction — nobles, ladies and families from more than 200 miles away arrived to help or attend!
